

2014 State Park Pass Descriptions



Annual & Multiple Pass: Annual: \$70 Provides entrance to all state parks. Valid for 12 months from date of purchase.

Multiple: \$35/each Annual pass holders may purchase a multiple pass for additional vehicles registered to the owner or the owner's immediate family members at the same address. Proof of ownership is required. Expiration month is the same as punched on the original annual purchased. Multiples are for non-commercial vehicles ONLY.

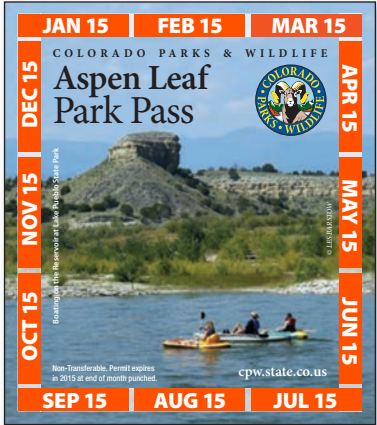
Aspen Leaf Annual & Aspen Leaf Multiple Pass:

Annual: \$60 Multiple: \$30/each

Must be a Colorado Resident and at least 64 years old at time of purchase. A Colorado vehicle registration must be provided when purchasing. Valid for 12 months from date of purchase. Seniors must be in the vehicle for the pass to be valid. Expiration month of Aspen Leaf multiple is the same as punched on the original Aspen Leaf annual purchased.

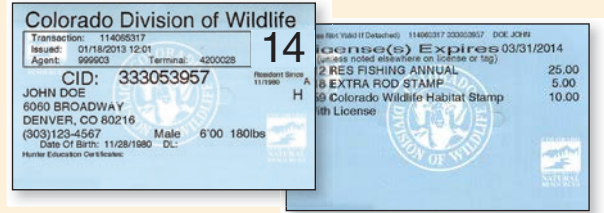
Aspen Leaf Free Annual Pass

No charge if: The Aspen Leaf Free Annual Pass is available to any resident who was born prior to 1923 and had an Aspen Leaf Passport prior to January 1985. An affidavit must be signed and proof of age and vehicle registration must be shown. Aspen Leaf Passport holder will receive one free pass per year.



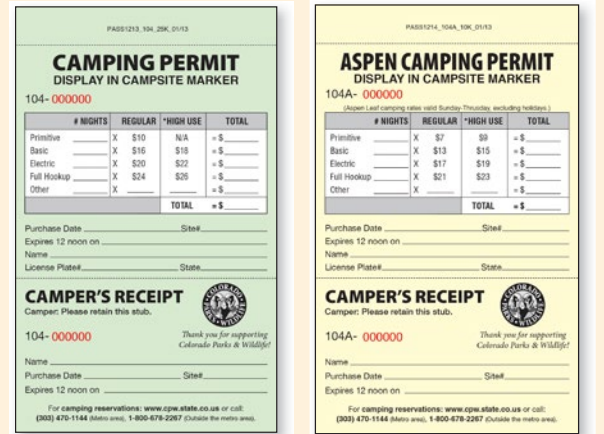

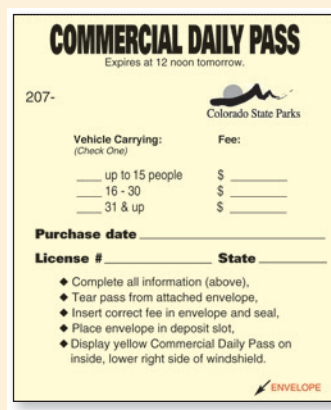

Colorado Disabled Veterans License Plate

Admitted Free

No vehicle pass shall be required for any resident's vehicle displaying a Colorado disabled veteran's license plate. Veteran must be in vehicle.



Volunteer Annual Passes

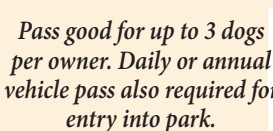
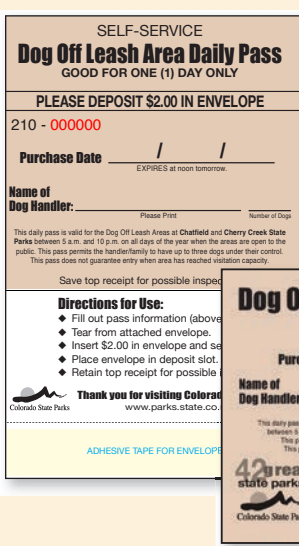


Volunteers are eligible for the pass after 48 hours of service during a consecutive 12-month period. Passes can be obtained through the park manager at the park(s) where they're volunteering. Senior pass available to volunteers 64 or older.

Dog Off-Leash Area Passes (Cherry Creek and Chatfield only)

\$20 annual or \$2 per day

Pass good for up to 3 dogs per owner. Daily or annual vehicle pass also required for entry into park.



In addition to the entrance pass fee, a fee is collected for the Cherry Creek Basin Water Quality Authority at Cherry Creek State Park.
